This report on the financial statements of South Cerney Parochial Church Council for the year ended 31 December 2016.

Respective Responsibilities of the P. C. C. and Examiner

#### Basis of this Report

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#### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

#### FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2016

#### 1. PRESENTATION OF FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The financial statements of the PCC have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2008 using the Receipts and Payments basis.

#### 2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements include monetary transactions, assets and liabilities for which the PCC can be held responsible. They do not include the accounts of any Church groups that owe an affiliation to any other body, (namely Mothers Union) nor those that are informal gatherings of Church members. Receipts are included as received and expenditure when irrevocably paid. Restricted funds must be used for the purposes for which the money was given or donated. General funds represent unrestricted money that can be used for the general charitable purposes of the PCC. Designated funds represent unrestricted money that has been earmarked for a specific purpose by the PCC. This money may be undesignated by the PCC at anytime.

The PCC's funds are separated into the following categories:-

#### General Funds

These are funds that the PCC has total control over with no outside restriction on the way in which the money is spent.

These accounts show these funds being split into two main categories, i.e general purposes and specific purposes; general purposes are those for which the PCC is responsible on a day to day basis, whereas the specific purposes are those which the PCC have decided should be donated to outside bodies, (e.g. the Royal British Legion at the Remembrance Day Service) or for which Church members have specifically raised money.

#### Restricted Funds

During the year, one of the restricted funds was transferred out of the PCC to the committee responsible for it. There are two Restricted Funds which must be used for the purpose for which the money was donated. The transactions on these funds during the year under review are shown on page 6.

#### Endowment Funds

Endowment Funds represent money that must be retained and cannot be spent other than for the purposes specified.

The PCC consider that the accounts in respect of the Head and Foot Trust, the Organ Fund, the Flower Fund and the Church Choir Fund do not come within this definitions as they are not within the sole-control of the PCC; the accounts for these are shown on pages 14 to 17 for information purposes only.

#### 3. QUOTA

The parish's share of the Deanery apportionment is allocated by the Deanery using a formula based on a mutual support system. The 2016 Quota was paid in full during the year.

#### 4. CLERGY EXPENSES

The clergy were reimbursed travelling expenses at the recommended diocesan rate. It is the policy of the PCC to reimburse out of pocket expenses in full.

#### 5. BANK ACCOUNTS

- The general bank accounts are held with NatWest Bank and Lloyds Bank, and are in the name of the PCC.
- The Discretionary Charity Fund account is held in a CBF Church of England Deposit account in the name of the PCC.
- No other accounts are restricted or designated: the bank balance has therefore been apportioned amongst the various funds in the Balance Sheet.

## 6. CAPITAL ASSETS

Office equipment, along with certain other items of a capital nature are written off as they are purchased. In general all items of equipment are maintained and serviced as necessary, and are in good condition. All such items are covered by insurance.
