6      **Finance:**

8. **Deanery Synod report on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2017 meeting:**

The minutes and summary are attached. Jennifer May gave her comments on a long meeting as follows:

The Area Dean spoke about possible developments for a sports ministry to get alongside the younger generation who are often engaged with matches on Sunday mornings. Scripture Union are at present discussing possibilities with the Diocese.

We shared ideas given by churches for outreach in their parishes and ways of welcoming newcomers, particularly in areas where there are new housing developments in place or planned.

We were challenged by Arthur Champion, the Diocesan Environmental Adviser to look at what we are doing to care for God's creation. Are we looking into the possibility of using "green" suppliers of electricity or planting wild areas in churchyard to encourage wildlife for example. A Questionnaire has been prepared, and we hope that All Hallows would at least get a Bronze Award on completion!

Concern was expressed concerning the changes in BBC policy regarding religious programmes and the state of religious education in schools. Recommendations have been prepared about teacher training issues in particular.
